5 Rounds: Saturday 9.30am, 1pm, 4.30pm. Sunday 9.30am, 1pm.

Prize giving 4.30pm Sunday.

All games will be submitted for FIDE and long play ECF grading.

Two half-point byes can be taken in any round by notifying the organisers in advance.

Time Control: All moves in 90 minutes.

Please note: All competitors must be U18 and Gold or Platinum Members of the English Chess Federation. Existing Bronze or Silver Membership can be upgraded online. ECF Membership number required on entry.

Entry Fee £20 for FIDE-rated juniors, £30 for non-FIDE rated juniors.

Long Play U100 Section:

First Prize: Chess Lesson with Robin Slade, £50 and DGT2010 Digital Chess Clock. Other prizes according to entry.

6 Rounds: Sat and Sun 9.30am, 12pm and 2.15pm. Prize giving 4.30pm Sunday.

Time Control: All moves in 60 minutes.

All games will be submitted for long play ECF grading.

Please Note: All competitors must be at least Silver ECF members and have a long play and rapid play grade below 100 in the January 2018 list. ECF Membership number required on entry for confirmation.

Entry Fee: £30 for each player.
